SUBJECT: Call to the 53rd EANGUS Annual Conference and Exhibition

DATE: June 10, 2024

1. The 53rd Annual Conference of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS) convenes at the Huntington Place Convention Center, 1 Washington Blvd, Detroit, MI from Sunday, 18 August 2024 through Wednesday, 21 August 2024. All conference information is published on the EANGUS Conference Website: <https://eangusconference.org>. Information will be updated as it becomes available. The final EANGUS Conference Agenda will be released and posted online on 1 August 2024.

2. Lodging. The EANGUS conference room block rate is \$145 per night +tax at the Marriot Detroit Marriott at the Renaissance Center, 400 Renaissance Center, Detroit, MI. The hotel reservation cutoff is 26 July 2024. Reservations can be made online at the conference website using group code EANGUS2024.

3. Registration. The conference registration is free for all actively serving enlisted members of EANGUS and spouses until 1 July 2024. After that date, all registrations will be \$195 per person. Professional Development attendees will be free up until the day of the conference. There is a collection of \$100 per person that is collected for each registration (excluding PD attendees) that will be applied to each attendee's hotel room, or the \$100 can be reimbursed to attendees after checking in for the conference. There are no refunds available after 5 July 2024, but a registration may be transferable. All registrations must go through the conference website.

5. Travel. The Detroit Metropolitan Airport (DTW) is located just outside of the city center of Detroit. The National Guard Association of Michigan (NGAM) has arranged for a shuttle service from the airport to the hotel. The shuttle schedule will be made available prior to the conference. Ride shares from the airport are also available.

6. Attire. Professional Development attendees and others on military orders are recommended to wear the uniform directed by their State Enlisted Leadership during daily professional development and business sessions. Delegates and other conference attendees are recommended to wear business casual attire. National Officers and Executive Council members are recommended to wear business attire. The All-States Banquet is a formal dinner: appropriate attire includes the Army Service Uniform formal or Mess Dress/Service Dress Uniform, formal gowns/cocktail dresses, and suit & tie. Evening events such as Welcome Night, Junior Enlisted, All Area Hospitality Night, and socials are for casual attire.

- b. Area Chairs will appoint one (1) Army Guard and one (1) Air Guard member from each Area to serve on the following:


